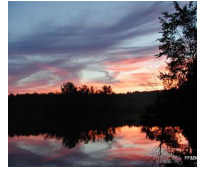

Some reminders:

* All watercraft including kayaks and canoes must have lettering at least 3" high identifying the member name. (ByLaw X, §4; House Rule I)

* Boats that are new to the lake should be inspected and approved by a member of the Board (including guest boats which must bear the name of the member in 3 inch letters). For a boat previously used on any other lake or waterway, the member must provide proof of

Our annual work party will be held on Saturday, May 27th with a breakfast at Trail's End at Lot #1 hosted by the Smith family beginning at 7:30am (all work party participants are invited - menu includes Eggs, Pancakes, Bacon, Sausage, Coffee, Tea, Juice and more).

The following day, Sunday, May 28th at 9:30am, all shareholders are invited to the Semi-Annual Meeting to discuss the business of the Club, including passage of the proposed 2017-18 budget, as well as to share news regarding Club activities, rules, water quality, Town issues and other concerns members may have. As always, the attendance of all members in good standing is requested and expected.

This email represents official delivery of the CALL TO MEETING by the Fallsburg Fishing & Boating Club pursuant to our Bylaws. Copies of the Call Sheet, Event Calendar, Annual Meeting Minutes from September 2016 and the proposed 2017-18 budget with other financial information etc are all

steam cleaning of the used boat, or certify that the boat has been checked, cleaned and dried/disinfected; in addition, every boat/watercraft (as well as equipment trailer) from another lake or waterway as well as any Pleasure Lake boat that has been stored anywhere outside Club property must be cleaned and inspected at the clubhouse cleaning station and the member must certify completion in the log prior to being launched into Pleasure Lake by members and/or third-parties in order to prevent the spread of any aquatic invasive species (AIS) in Pleasure Lake. (See Amended House Rule AO)

* Motors (including electric motors) may only be operated on the lake by members and specified family members – not guests or prospective members (House Rule C)

* All floats, rafts, docks and other items must be brought to shore and anchored securely each evening. No floats/rafts are allowed to remain offshore overnight. (HR AN)

* As to any Club lot, members must obtain permission

provided in the linked files above (simply click above to download); individual event flyers can also be downloaded by clicking the link after the event description below).

(These documents are also available to download and view at the top of the Members' Documents section of our website at www.pleasurelake.org . That page of our website is password protected, and all shareholders should have the password (reply to this email if you are a shareholder and need a password reminder). In addition, if you you have any difficulty opening this email or accessing the attached/linked documents, feel free to reply to this email or email Jim Creighton directly at jc@pleasurelake.org and he will email an additional copy to you.)

If for any reason you no would no longer like to receive your Call to Meeting packets by email, please reply to this email and confirm your postal address and your wish to have the Club mail them out via USPS (which the Club pays approximately \$1-2 per envelope per member). It is our hope that every member will provide an email address and choose electronic delivery in order to help keep your dues lower and avoid waste of paper.

Pleasure Lake Events:

from the Board of Directors before making any changes to the outside dimension of a cottage (including any addition) or any change to any other structure on a lot, or any alteration to the lot itself. (House Rule AG)

* Watch your road speeds – 10 mph on all Club roads except 5 mph below the West Shore Hill, and PLEASE CLOSE ALL GATES. :-)

* Garbage – Only household garbage in dumpster please, nothing else in or around. Kindly crush or fold cardboard recycling so it fits in the bins, and keep doing a great job separating your newspaper, cans and bottles for recycling.

* The stump dump is available to you for disposal of branches, stumps and leaves – nothing else (even if it is made out of wood - no lumber or furniture).

* All members should ensure that they are regularly servicing their septic systems.


* Finally, all residences on Club property are to be of a seasonal nature. (ByLaw X, §6)
