RULE REMINDERS

Thanks to all who follow the rules and work out issues with neighbors -- we value the courtesy and cooperation of all members of our Pleasure Lake community.

Some reminders:

- * All watercraft including kayaks and canoes must have lettering at least 3" high identifying the member name. (ByLaw X, §4; House Rule I)
- * Boats that are new to the lake should be inspected and approved by a member of the **Board** (including guest boats which must bear the name of the member in 3 inch letters). For a boat previously used on any other lake or waterway, the member must provide proof of

Members will also receive an update from our Aquatic Invasive Species (AIS) committee on the status of our control of Eurasian milfoil and water chestnut, Town efforts to handle issues upstream of our lake and our continued plans to monitor and fight AIS in the area.

This email represents official delivery of the CALL TO MEETING by the Fallsburg Fishing & Boating Club pursuant to our Bylaws. Copies of the Call Sheet, Event Calendar, Annual **Meeting Minutes from September 2016** and the proposed 2017-18 budget with other financial information etc are all

steam cleaning of the used boat, or certify that the boat has been checked, cleaned and dried/disinfected; in addition, every boat/watercraft (as well as equipment trailer) from another lake or waterway as well as any Pleasure Lake boat that has been stored anywhere outside Club property must be cleaned and inspected at the clubhouse cleaning station and the member must certify completion in the log prior to being launched into Pleasure Lake by members and/or third-parties in order to prevent the spread of any aquatic invasive species (AIS) in Pleasure Lake. (See Amended House Rule AO)

- * Motors (including electric motors) may only be operated on the lake by members and specified family members not guests or prospective members (House Rule C)
- * All floats, rafts, docks and other items must be brought to shore and anchored securely each evening. No floats/rafts are allowed to remain offshore overnight. (HR AN)
- * As to any Club lot, members must obtain permission

provided in the linked files above (simply click above to download); individual event flyers can also be downloaded by clicking the link after the event description below).

That page of our website is password protected, and all shareholders should have the password (reply to this email if you are a shareholder and need a password reminder).
